"50 Days to Your Pentecost" Devotional Challenge

Contrary to what many people think, Easter is not a single day, but a season that begins on Easter Sunday and continues for 7 weeks. This 7-week period is known as the **Great Fifty Days** or the **Week of Weeks**. During this time, the church celebrates the Lord's resurrection, His appearances to the disciples after Easter, His post-resurrection teachings, His ascension into heaven, and the disciples' eager anticipation of the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

To guide you through this season and to help you prepare to celebrate Pentecost on May 15, you are invited to use the devotional "50 days to your Pentecost." This 50-day, daily devotional will challenge you to taste, see, and hear God, not just as the Creator of the Universe, but as Heavenly Father.
